TOUR NAME Alberobello



The region of Apulia is famous for its storybook-like 'trulli' houses — round, whitewashed buildings with cone-shaped roofs made from grey stone. The exact origin of these quirky houses is unknown, but the tradition is thought to be around 5,000 years old. In the UNESCO-listed old town of Alberobello, you'll find a hundred or so of these dome dwellings, set on a hilltop surrounded by olive groves. Inside, rooms are separated with colorful curtains, and furnishings are handmade from olive wood by the local farmers who have lived here for generations. We'll have a guided tour of the town, including a stop at St Antonio, the only trullo church in the world. Afterwards, you'll have half an hour or so to wander around the town on your own.
