underground caverns acted as natural storage containers for farmers, until stories of resident monsters and ghosts scared locals into avoiding the area completely. They were uncovered again in 1938, and nowadays they're a popular spot with holidaymakers. You'll have an hour or so to wander through the 2-mile complex, admiring the spiky rock formations that decorate the caves. Visit the Grave, with its natural skylight, and the White Cave, which features a crystal-covered basin and milky-white stalagmites.
