TOUR NAME Brindisi Bike Tour



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If you like the idea of combining some time on the beach with something a bit more energetic, this trip will be right up your street. Leaving the port behind, you'll start your journey in the historical heart of Brindisi, where Romanesque churches huddle against cobbled piazzas and pastel-painted houses. Check out monuments like the statue-topped Cathedral and the stately portico of Porta dei Cavalieri Templari – all that remains of a 12th-century Crusader church. Also on the sightseeing hitlist is Brindisi's major claim-to-fame - the beautiful Roman column marking the end of the Via Appia, the ancient road that once linked Rome to the port. In 71 BC, Spartacus led his rebels south along the road, only to be captured and crucified just outside Brindisi. Turning our back on the city you'll make your way along the olive groves and vineyards of the surrounding countryside. Following the scenic coastal road, you'll come to Punta Penne Cape where you can kick back and enjoy the beach before cycling back to the port.
