A Taste of Sardinia

Get acquainted with Cagliari and meet the warm people of Sardinia who will introduce you to their culture, traditions, and treat you to a homemade feast of locally grown products. You'll begin with a motor coach drive to a viewpoint for a great view of Cagliari's Roman amphitheatre. Head through the city center to the ancient city walls and the 13th-century Tower of St Pancras. No coaches are allowed in the Old Town, so you will disembark the coach here and enter on foot for a 1½-hour walking tour. You'll find yourself surrounded by incredibly narrow streets lined with dilapidated palaces. The true gem is the cathedral, flanked by the Archbishop's Palace and the Governor's Palace. The cathedral was originally 13th-century Romanesque style with two magnificent marble pulpits, and a delightful Madonna, carved and gilded some 700 years ago. After some free time, re-board your coach for a drive up Mount Urpino, which offers a view of the entire city from the port of Cagliari and across Poetto Beach to the Molentargius Pond. Continue your drive past famous Poetto Beach. You're headed to the farming community Maracalagonis, where you'll visit Casa Atzeri. The owner of the house, Mr Vincenzo, is the perfect representative of the culture and traditions of Sardinia. You'll mix with local people in traditional costume, and a typical folk show will entertain you as you enjoy a taste of genuine Sardinian hospitality. Specialties served may include homemade bread, local cheeses, vegetables, olives and salamis. Afterwards, feel free to join in the dance. You'll also taste the local wine and Mirto—a sweet desert wine.
