In the northwest corner of Tuscany lies the ancient city of Lucca, which started out as a Roman colony in 177 BC and graduated to provincial capital of Tuscany in the Middle Ages. A 45-minute drive from Livorno will bring you to this gorgeous walled city, where you will set out with your guide on a walking tour through its narrow, winding streets. Once you reach the Church of San Michele, you will be given the option of free time to explore on your own, or remaining with your guide. Continue to the Church of San Frediano, founded in the 6th century and also view the Piazza Anfiteatro—built upon the remains of an ancient Roman Amphitheatre. After your free time or guided tour, you will meet back in Piazzale Verdi to re-board your motor coach. You are now headed to Pisa, where the coach will park outside the Old Town and you will walk to Miracle Square. A highlight of your day will be a guided tour inside the massive cathedral and the stunning baptistery, and around the outside of justifiably famous Leaning Tower.
