TOUR NAME Coastal Sights & Seaside Delights







Drive through the main streets of Palermo, along the coast and through Favorita Park. It is said that Ferdinand III of Bourbon, having fled from Naples in 1798 with his wife Marie Caroline, took refuge on the slopes of Mount Pellegrino. He called his estate Favorita. The spectacular panorama of the green Piana del Gallo extends as far as the sea, forming the sandy boundary of the bay of Mondello. In 1911, an Italo-Belga Company was authorized to build roads and facilities here, radically transforming the bay. Cafés, bars, shops, restaurants, and a host of attractions combine to make Mondello a lively seaside resort. Upon arrival in Mondello, you'll stroll along the promenade to the local beach. There, relax, enjoy the sun or take a swim. Each guest will have the use of a sun-bed and shared umbrella (two quests per umbrella). En route back to the ship, you will pass through the center of town, along via Liberta—the most important street in the city. See Teatro Politeama—the theater built in the 19th century—and via Ruggero Settimo, known for its elegant shops. Pass via Magueda, and the neo-Classical Teatro Massimo, and Palermo's Opera House built at the end of the 19th century.
